 - Development of a portfolio platform to present a Federation of Cyber Ranges across Europe in order to provide Cyber training facilities to the consortium and to others
 - Sharing scenarios and best practice guidelines

 - Research Institute CODE, Masaryk University, RISE, Université de Lorraine, Airbus




Threat Intelligence @ CONCORDIA

Building Threat Intelligence platform for Europe

 for sharing cybersecurity information across academic, industrial and other organizations, involving especially the European CERT

community

 Developing sector-specific Threat Intelligence platforms (e.g. Telco, Finance, ...)





Certification and Standardization @ CONCORDIA

- A key ingredient of a successful standard is contribution from a variety of expert sources
- Having this in mind CONCORDIA is an ideal breeding ground for the exploitation and contribution to existing international best practices and the creation of new ones especially in the areas of
 - Cybersecurity measures, techniques, methods etc. and
 - Cybersecurity skills
- At the end of the applicable process, independent assessments will be carried out against these standards with the aim to provide the appropriate validation (this includes people as well as process assessments)



Cybersecurity Skills developed by CONCORDIA (1)

Skills - Community impact and sustainability

2 main objectives:

- Develop the CONCORDIA Cybersecurity Ecosystem with virtual labs, services and training activities
- Create a sustainable CONCORDIA European Education Ecosystem for Cybersecurity

Along with:

- Threat intelligence platform open source
- DDoS Clearing house pilot
- Community building, support & incentive models mechanisms



Cybersecurity Skills developed by CONCORDIA (2)

Skills - Cybersecurity ecosystem

- Virtual labs
 - Lab infrastructure to support the development of solutions
 - Hosting infrastructure & personnel for the European Threat Intelligence platform
 - Testing and validation capabilities in support of certification
- Services
 - Portfolio of tools (public and proprietary) & best practices for design, analysis and testing of Cybersecurity systems
- Training for professionals
 - Capture-the-Flag, Red-Blue-teaming events (plan/execute/review)
 - Cyber range training develop realistic scenarios to address the evolving cyber threat landscape



Cybersecurity Skills developed by CONCORDIA (3)

Skills – Education Ecosystem

- Pooling, and disseminating existing courses for professionals
- Methodology for creation of new courses and/or teaching materials
- Develop new courses for mid-level managers and executives
- Develop a framework for CONCORDIA certificate for courses
- Teach-the Teachers courses and guidelines
- Networking activities
